How to Pray for Your Child

1. Pray that **NOTHING** hinders your child from accepting Jesus Christ as his/her personal Savior early in life (Matthew 19.14).
2. Pray that your child learns to know God and will have a deep desire to do God's will for his/her life (Psalm 119.27,30,34-35).
3. Pray that your child hears stories from the Bible that will be a basis for his/her decisions throughout life (Psalm 71.17).
4. Pray that your child will develop a keen sense of right and wrong and that he/she will truly hate evil and cling to what is good (Psalm 139.23-4).

5. Pray that your child will increase in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man. This prayer covers his/her total development to his/her full potential (Luke 2.52).
6. Pray that your child will develop a thankful heart and a positive mental attitude (Romans 8.31).
7. Pray that God will protect your child from Satan and his tricks and deceptions (John 17.55).
8. Pray that God would destroy the enemies in his/her life whether they be lying, selfishness, anger, weaknesses, laziness, or worry (Psalm 120.2).
9. Pray that God would make him/her successful in the work He has for him/her to do (Psalm 118.25; Joshua 1.8-9).
10. Pray that he/she will have a strong sense of belonging to a family that is loving and lives together in

- unity (Colossians 3.12-14).
11. Pray that he/she respects authority (Romans 13.1; Ephesians 6.1-4).
12. Pray that his/her entire life will be a testimony of the greatness and love of Jesus Christ (Philippians 2.15-16)
13. Pray that your child is filled with the hope that God provides through the Holy Spirit (Romans 5.5).
14. Pray that God uses your child to impact the world, so that He is further honored in person after person (1 Chronicles 16.23-29).
